Creative Arts Competition

- 1. The organization and individuals listed in the coordinating committee are not responsible for loss, damage, or injury to exhibitors or exhibits.
- 2. The exhibitor may enter as many articles as desired. Each entry costs \$2.
- 3. If rules are not followed, entry will not be placed.
- 4. There will be three age groups:

1) K-2nd, Clover Kids

3) 9th - 12th Senior Division

2) 3rd-8th, Junior Division

4) Adult (18 & Up)

- 5. First through fifth place ribbons will be given in each class. Participation ribbons will be given through 2nd grade.
- 6. Rosettes will be awarded to the category winners in each age group. Blue rosette winners will be chosen from 1st place ribbons in each class.
- 7. Recipes that have won a first place rosette in past project show may not be entered again by the same exhibitor.
- 8. All exhibits must have been made during the last calendar year since the last project show. Special exceptions are made to Ag. Mechanics.
- 9. All items must be checked in by the preceeding Thursday at 12:00 PM. Entries may be turned into 715 Rowlett Road, Garland or 10056 Marsh Lane Suite B-101, Dallas. Entries may be mailed if they are received by this time. Entries will not be mailed back and must be picked up in-person on Saturday. Mail to:

Judging will take place Friday, with entries displayed to the public on Saturday during the North Texas Livestock & Creative Arts Show.

- 10. Name must be concealed on any entry.
- 11. Superintendents will have the final say in all category interpretation.
- 12. Entries are released for pickup from 2-4 pm on Saturday, March 7 from the North Texas Livestock and Creative Arts Show at Fair Park. Alternatively, entries may be picked up from Dallas Road and Bridge 1 (715 Rowlett Road) March 9-13 from 10 am 2 pm. Items not picked up by March 13 at 2 pm will be discarded.
- 13. Entry forms and categories are available at dallas-tx.tamu.edu/creativearts
- 14. All food entries must be prepared "from scratch".

No Refrigerated Pies or Cakes allowed

Participants are not required to exhibit the entire recipe. e.g. recipe that makes 3 loaves of bread. You need only display one loaf, or a recipe that makes 3 dozen cookies, you need only to display 1 dozen. A copy of the recipe is <u>REQUIRED</u> with the entry.

- 15. Preserved foods must be labeled with date of preservation. <u>Standard canning jars are required.</u>
- 17. All items must be displayed on sturdy disposable plates or containers.
- 18. All products must be covered with clear plastic wrap or contained in a zip top bag. **Please do not display your item on glass or any type of returnable containers.
- 19. Framing and/or mounting will not be scored in photography.
- 20. All textile entries must be clean.thing must be on hangers.
- 21. Framing and/or mounting will not be scored in photography.
- 22. Photographs must be at least 5" X 7" and do not have to be framed.
- 23. Machine Division consists of items made using some type of machine.(Ex: sewing machine, embroidery machine, etc.)
- 24. All textile entries must be clean; Clothing must be on hangers.
- 25. Handwork Division must be done by hand, no machine work.
